<u>Suggested activities you could do over the weekend:</u>

*Visit the library and let your child choose their own books to read. *Read a book to your child every day and ask them who, what, where, why, how questions about the book.

*Help your child to practise writing their name using their name card. *Teach your child to wear their own coat, shoes, wellies, scarf and gloves. *Encourage them to hold a pair of scissors in one hand and make snips on some paper. Can they cut around some shapes? They could make a snowflake. *Go through the key vocabulary and what the words mean.
