- *Watch the story using on You Tube and talk to your child about it.*
- *Introduce your child to different textures and model using new words (key vocabulary)*
- *Practise counting and recognising numbers at every opportunity*
- *Help your child to practise writing their name using their name card.*
- *Teach your child to wear their own coat, shoes, wellies, scarf and gloves.*
- *Sing the rhymes in the new rhyme book. We will give you a new rhyme every week to add to it.*
- *Find words that rhyme with each other, such as rocks, socks, box etc*
