Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you and yours are safe and well.

Thank you for keeping your children safe at home last week.

Please let me know if your circumstances have changed and you now require a place for your child because they have a Social Worker, an Education and Health Care Plan or one parent on the Critical Worker list.

The Government guidance confirms, as a baseline, under the national lockdown, the expectation is that everybody should work from home, where possible. I know that you have been doing so as offences for non-attendance in schools during this time have been temporarily disappled until 6th February 2021.

I want to thank our staff for going above and beyond at this time to ensure our children's quality learning offer continues from home. If you feel your child is not receiving suitable remote education, please raise your concern initially with your child's teacher or Mrs Dweh, the Senior Leader with overarching responsibility for the quality of delivery of remote learning.

As per the most recent update in Government guidance, we will now be offering childcare to our Nursery children, mornings only, from Wednesday 13th January. Again, most parents have chosen to keep their children safe at home at this time.

The school office is open Monday-Friday from 8.30a.m.-3.30p.m. every day for face to face and telephone enquiries, collection of learning packs for some pupils and safeguarding concerns.
