Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you very much for your continued support and for helping your children with their learning during these very challenging times. Staff are particularly appreciative of the feedback we have received and the great relationships strengthened by your communication and collaboration.

We have been preparing to ensure that Barham is a safe and stimulating learning environment for all. As we look forward to returning to school next week, please:

1. Talk your children through any concerns they may have about returning
2. Continue to monitor the high quality completion of home learning assignments as this forms part of our blended learning offer
3. Limit screen time to a minimum
4. Ensure you allocate daily Reading time at home
5. Introduce or maintain daily, outdoor physical activity, e.g. walking, cycling, etc.

Please be reminded that daily **school attendance is mandatory** as it is your statutory duty. Any Emergency Leave would need to include Government imposed travel quarantine therefore your child's school place would be at risk. Contact the school if you have further enquiries.

When making enquiries at our front Reception Desk, please wear a mask and maintain social distance from each other. Please remember to wear a mask over your nose and mouth and socially distance everywhere on school premises, including outdoors.

We will be enriching our face to face learning for the next four weeks (**Monday 8th March to Thursday 1st April**) with practical, investigative, discussions, hands on, reading, handwritten, physical lessons. This will enable us to assess where children are and close any gaps over the next few months. Our children are far more resilient than we know and I have every confidence that working together, they can continue to make accelerated progress.
