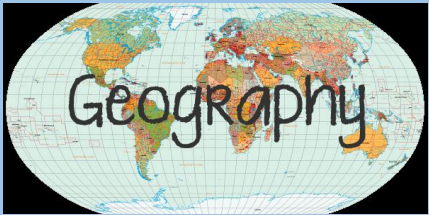

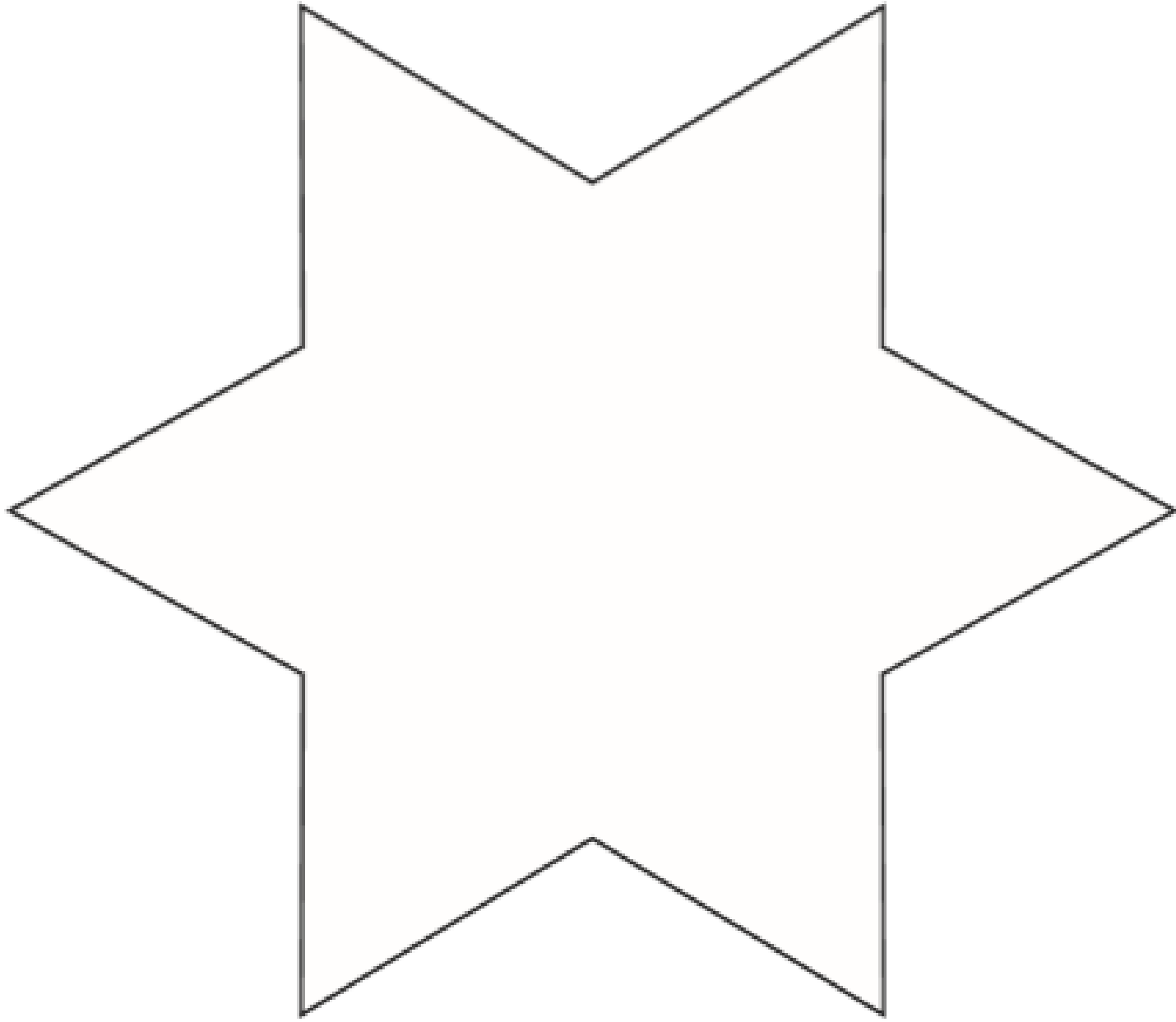
What Makes Me Special?

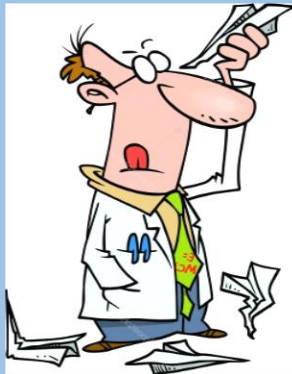
