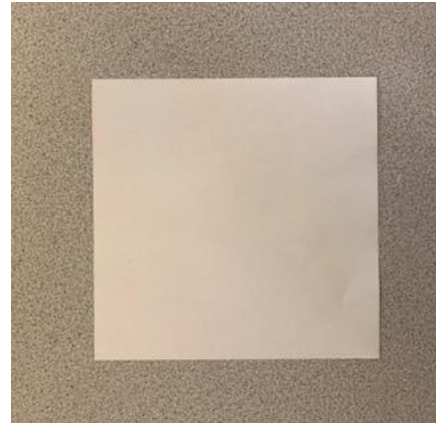
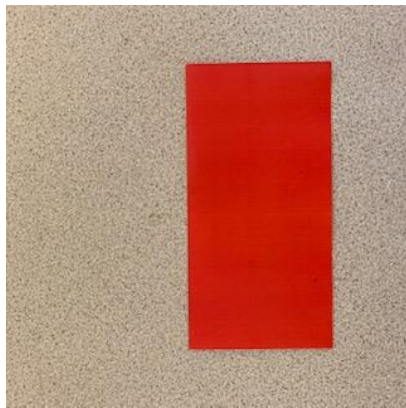


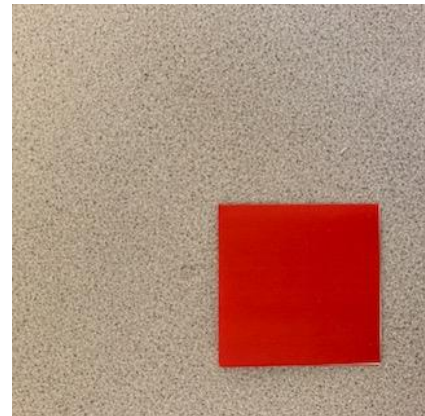
1. Begin your rose with a square shaped piece of paper. One side should be red, the other side white.



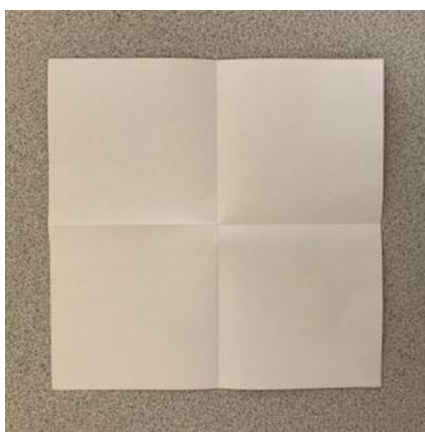
2. Before you start your rose make sure the white side is facing up.



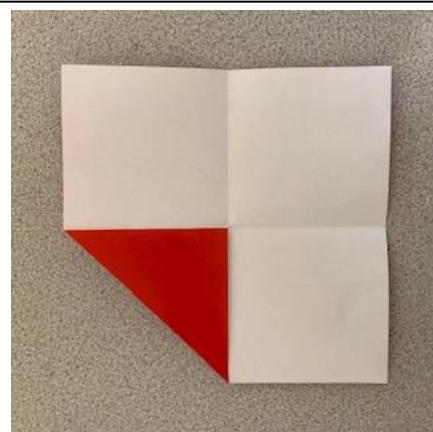
3. Fold your paper in half down the middle.



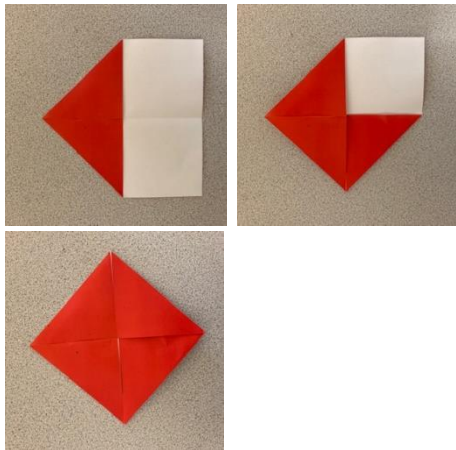
4. Fold in half again.



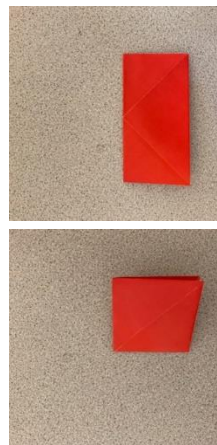
5. Open out your paper. The fold lines you have made are your guide lines.



6. Take one corner and fold it into the centre point.



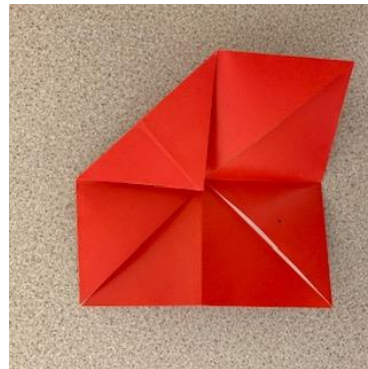
7. Repeat this with all the corners, folding each to the centre point.



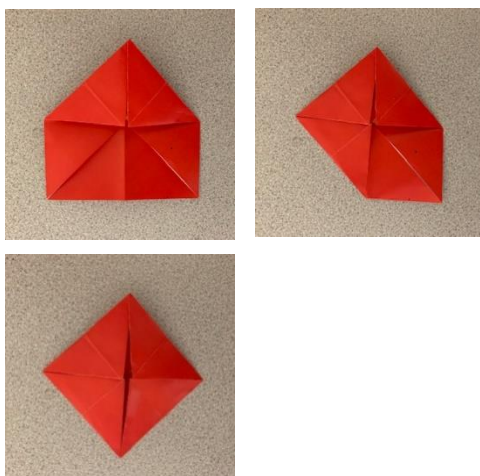
8. Fold your new square into quarters, giving you new guide lines.



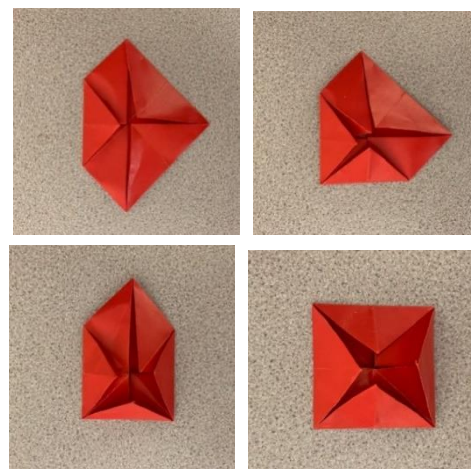
9. It should look like the above picture.



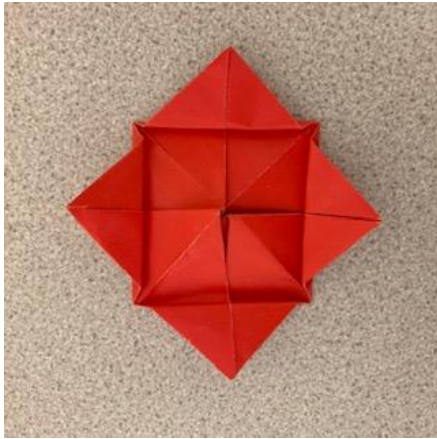
10. Repeat the step of folding the corners into the centre.



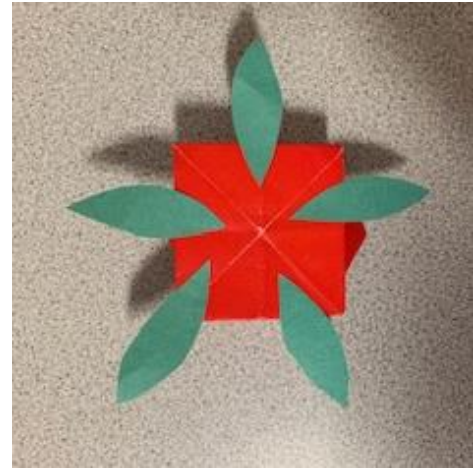
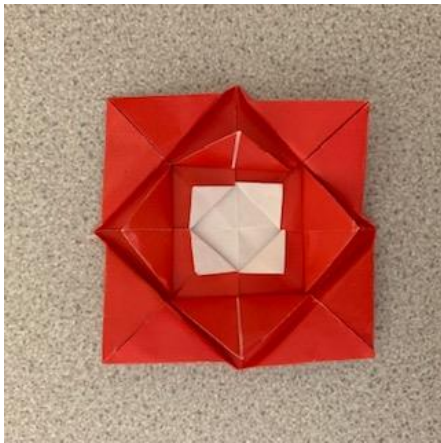
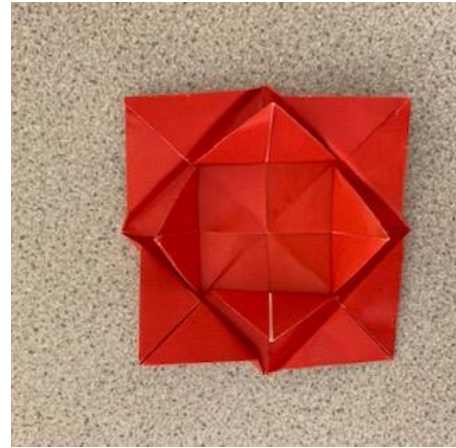
11. The process should look like the above picture.



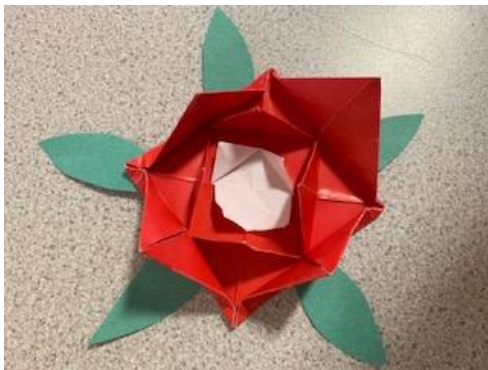
12. Fold in all the corner points to the centre one final time.



13. Carefully fold the layers back to reveal your petals.



14. Stick paper leaves to the back of your rose.



15. You now have your completed Tudor rose.
