Pedestrian Safety Reminders



Look left then right then left again.

Put devices down when crossing the street.

Children under 10 should cross street with an adult.



Do not allow play in or around vehicles.

Check for children before backing up from your driveway or parking stall.

Hold hands with small children as they enter and exit vehicles in the driveway.

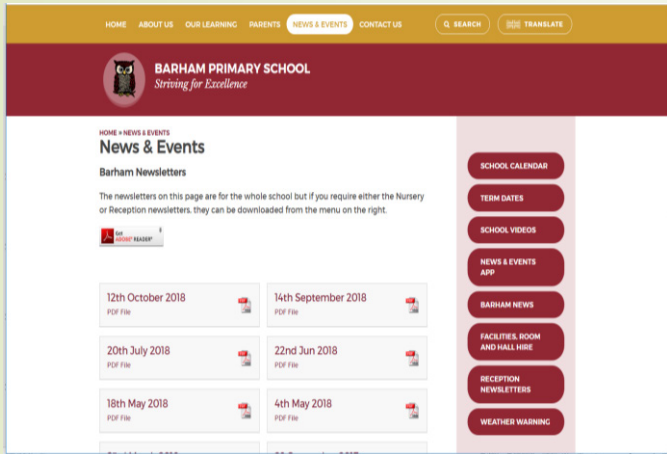

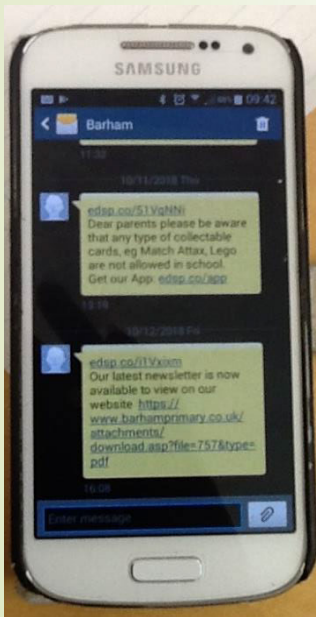

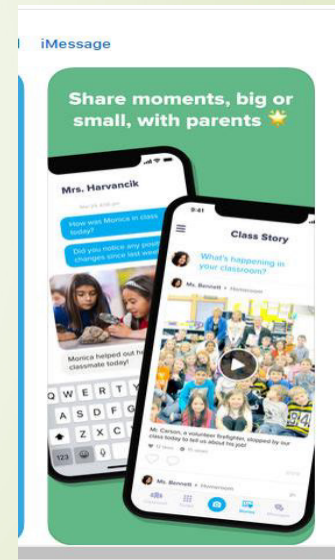
