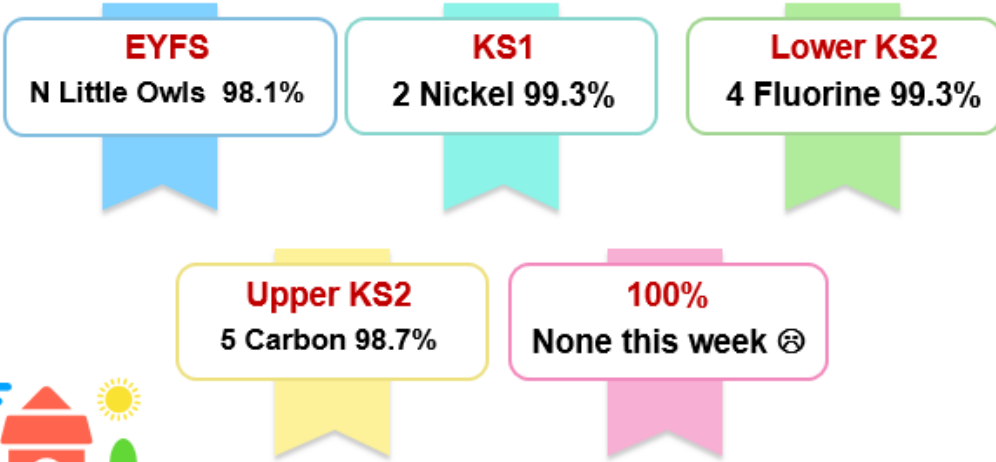

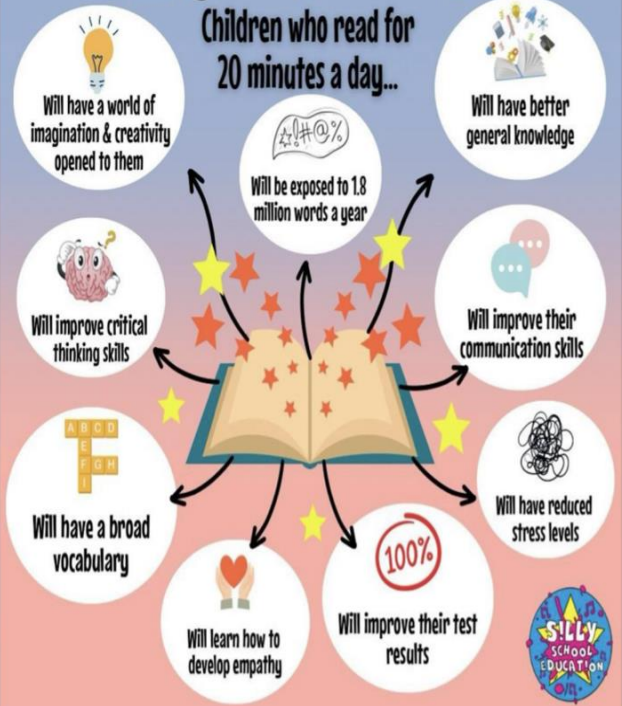

Deadline	31 October 2024	15 January 2025
