Pupil Premium - Information/staff responsibilities

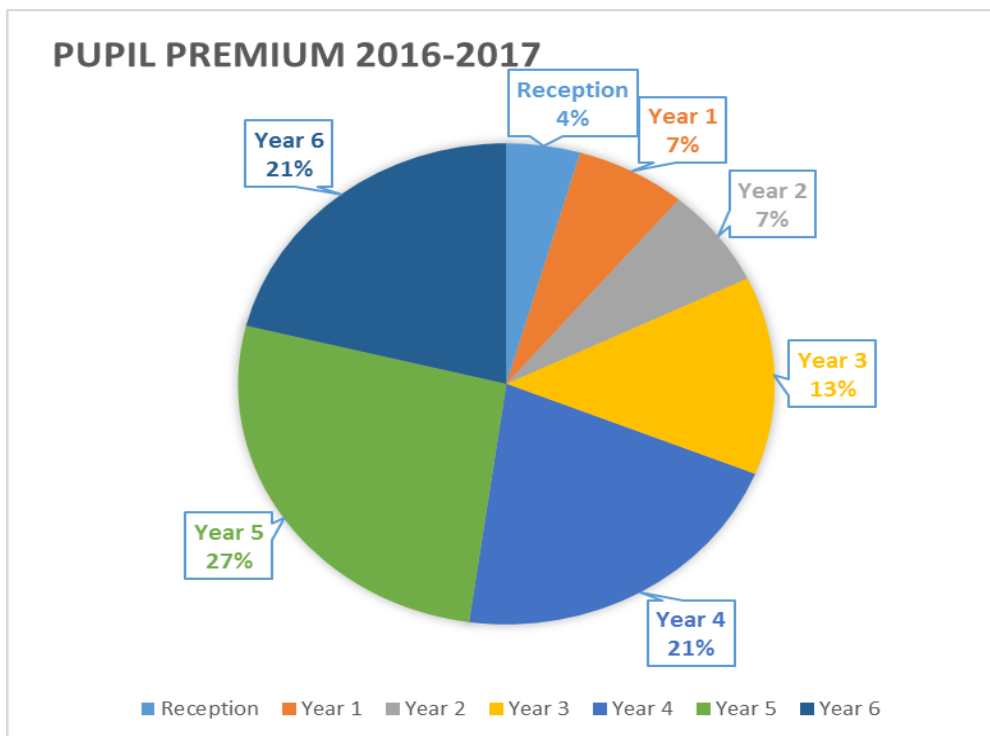
Pupil Premium children are those who have been eligible for FSM (Free School Meals) at any stage in their primary schooling ('Ever 6' means ever eligible over last 6 years). Also included are 'Looked After' (fostered) children and Service children (Army/Navy etc.).

Additional funding is provided to ensure that PP children attain at least as well as their peers when compared both within school and against national statistics. The funding is designed to 'narrow the gap' in attainment that has been prevalent for this group of children over time – as a group they underperform.

It is incumbent upon all staff at Barham to be specifically aware of the comparative performance of these children and ensure that they are prioritised for interventions that will help to 'narrow the gap'. This means considering them first when planning activities to meet the needs of certain groups.

Pupil Premium children who are on track to attain in line with or above their peers, and who are making good progress, may need bespoke use of the pupil premium to narrow the gap. At Barham we are striving for accelerated progress for all children and a mix of PP and non-PP children in an intervention or activity is often a good move.

Monitoring, tracking, measuring and accounting for the provisions made to 'narrow the gap' is especially important since pupil premium funding has to be accounted for separately and in terms of impact.



Currently we have 896 pupils on roll from Nursery to Year 6

Out of the 807 pupils from Reception to Year 6 we have 90(11%) pupils that are identified as being Pupil Premium children
