Suggested activities you could do over the weekend:

- *Visit the library and let your child choose their own books to read.
- *Read a book to your child every day and ask them who, what, where, why, how questions about the book.
- *Watch 'Going on a lion hunt' on YouTube and practise retelling the story using actions.
- *Practise counting and recognising numbers at every opportunity
- *Practise using positional language. For example, can you put the teddy under/on top/behind the table?
- *Help your child to practise writing their name using their name card.
- *Teach your child to wear their own coat, shoes, wellies, scarf and gloves.
- *Sing the rhymes in the new rhyme book. We will give you a new rhyme every week to add to it.
